F. Scott Jackson concentrates in real-estate law and is a founding shareholder of Jackson DeMarco Peckenpaugh. He chairs the common interest subdivision group of the firm, which has created over 1,000 community associations.

Jackson has authored several books and articles including two chapters in California Condominium and Planned Development Practice, published by the California State Bar.
